Taxonomy icon is a collection of icons (illustrations) of biological species that is free to use and distribute. There are more than 200 icons of various species including Bacteria, Fungi, Protista, Plantae and Animalia.

- Easy access to icons
 - There are two different ways to access the icons.
- Search a specific icon by keywords.
- Choose icons using the biological classification tree.
- · Select the size and background color of your choice
- Sizes: Large (120×190 pixel) / Small (32×24 pixel)
- Background: Colored / Transparent
- Share and remix icons just by giving attribution
 Users can copy, distribute, transmit and adapt icons in their works, such as documents for presentation purposes and original websites.

- A link to the NCBI Entrez database
 Most icons are linked to the NCBI database via the NCBI taxonomy browser.
